

Role of Adviser-Coach

Skills Set and Job Description

The role of the Adviser-Coach is to create the optimum conditions that enable a group of young people to gain a better understanding of the realities of marriage in our society today. This is done through exploring the experience of married couples in either a Half Day Conference or a classroom session.

Skills required:

- Interest in working with young people
- Ability to engage with young people including running a class session
- Ability to develop a rapport with young people and enable them to explore their hopes and fears for future relationships
- Assist them in the framing of questions to be put to married couples during dialogue with couples

Job Specification

- Sympathetic to aims of Explore
- A background in education or youth work may be beneficial
- Confident/comfortable in a classroom setting
- Ability to advise/support couples before dialogue with young people
- Ability to adapt/have lightness of touch when running class session
- Integrity/Confidentiality essential
- Encourage young people to express their hopes and fears for future relationships
- Ability to identify/summarise key issues/themes raised during dialogue between couples and students
